Muhsin Khan Translation: (Aayat Al-Kursi)

Allah! La ilaha illa Huwa (none has the right to be worshipped but He), the Ever Living, the One Who sustains and protects all that exists. Neither slumber, nor sleep overtake Him. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on earth. Who is he that can intercede with Him except with His Permission? He knows what happens to them (His creatures) in this world, and what will happen to them in the Hereafter . And they will never compass anything of His Knowledge except that which He wills. His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and He feels no fatigue in guarding and preserving them. And He is the Most High, the Most Great. (Surat Al-Baqarah 2:255)

- A) Whoever reads this after every Fard prayer, nothing prevents him/her from Jennah except that he is still living.
- B) Whoever says this when he rises in the morning will be protected from jinns until he retires in the evening, and whoever says it when retiring in the evening will be protected from them until he rises in the morning. It was reported by Al-Hakim 1 / 562, Al-Albani graded it as authentic in Sahihut-Targhib wat-Tarhib 1/273, and traces it to An-Nasa'i and At-Tabarani. He says that At-Tabarani's chain of transmission is reliable (Jayyid).
- C) It has from Allah's greatest names in it: Al-Hayy (The Ever-Living) & Al-Qayyuum (The One who Sustains and Protects all that Exists); Al-'Aliy (The Most High) & Al-'Atheem (The Most Great)
- D) It is a protection for you and your family/household from Jinn and Shaytaan
- E) Prophet Muhammad Salla Allahu 'Alayhi wa Sallam said that it's "the Greatest Aya" in the Quran
