حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ
وَهُوَ رَبُّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ

**HasbiyAllaahu laa 'ilaaha 'illaa Huwa 'alayhi
tawakkaltu wa Huwa Rabbul-'Arshil-'Atheem**

*Allah is sufficient for me . There is none worthy of worship but Him . I have placed my
trust in Him, He is Lord of the Majestic Throne .*

(Recite seven times in Arabic in the Morning and Evening.)

**Whoever recites this seven times every day upon entering the morning
and upon entering the evening, Allah will suffice him with all of his
concerns from those affairs of the Dunya (the affairs of this life) and the
Aakhira (the Hereafter)**

Reference: Ibn As-Sunni (no. 71). Both reports are attributed directly to the
Prophet Salla Allah 'Alayhi wa Sallam (Marfu). The chain of transmission is sound
(Sahih). Ibn As-Sunni. Sh. Ibn Uthaymeen (Rahimahu Allah) mentioned it in his
book "The Precious Remembrance."

Note:

**By morning it refers to after Fajr (according to some before the rising of
the sun) (according to others after sunrise is okay) and by evening, one
may read it after 'Asr (according to some scholars) or at Maghrib
(according to other scholars).**
